

Instrumentation: 2 altos, 2 tenors, 2 trumpets, 2 trombones, piano, bass, drumset. Optional Parts: 2 flutes, 2 clarinets, baritone horn TC / tenor sax, F horn, baritone saxophone, tuba, guitar, and vibraphone. Plavable with reduced instrumentation.

JAZZ BAND Grades 3–31/2

Full Instrumentation: 5 saxes, 4 trumpets, 4 trombones, 4 rhythm. *Optional Parts:* flute, F horn, 1/2/3 baritone horn TC / tenor sax, tuba, and vibraphone.



PREMIER JAZZ Grades 4–5

Full Instrumentation: 5 saxes, 4 trumpets, 4 trombones, 4 rhythm.



PATRICK WILLIAMS Grade 6

Full Instrumentation: 5 saxes, 4 trumpets, 4 trombones, 4 rhythm. Additonal optional parts vary.



JAZZ VOCAL Grades 3–3½ Full Instrumentation: vocal solo, 5 saxes, 4 trumpets, 4 trombones, 4 rhythm.

Practice Tools for Beginning Jazz Students

Learning to swing is easier with SmartMusic. Automatic rhythmic assessments can be adjusted from light bebop swing feel to the dotted eighth swing of heavy shuffle.

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
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

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
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
