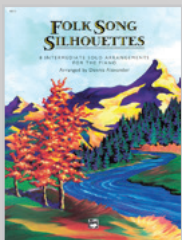
When Johnny Comes Marching Home

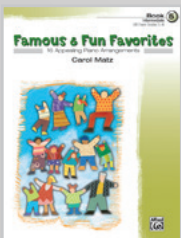
