A jazz ensemble should always try to find its energy output "sweet spot." What does this mean? The sweet spot is all about playing with efficiency, and how much output or power the band can deliver. When the band can play with dynamics, have a core sound that is focused, deliver blend and balance, hear each other, and ultimately produce a cohesive and full sound as an ensemble—then you have found the sweet spot. Strive to make the the peak volume 80 percent effort level—save a bit more for when the band really needs it!
