


Print this page on colorful paper or cardstock while printing the instructions (on page 2) on white paper. This will ensure that you have black and white keys and sheet music, with a fun colored piano!

## Instructions:

1. Cut out the Alfred Music piano origami template (You may reproduce it for each student on colorful paper or cardstock)







3. Fold both ends into the middle, touching them to each other, on the center line (This will create a square shape.)



 Separate each end from the middle by inserting your finger between the folds and folding them down into a triangle shape. (The paper will now look like a little house.)




5. Fold the bottom center flap up to touch the top of the paper.






6. Then fold the top half of the flap back down to create a crease in the middle of the flap.



7. Fold each of the paper's sides in to line up with the sides of the flap.



8. Bring the center flap down and the two sides in to create an upright piano shape.



9. Cut out the image of the piano keys below and glue it to the keyboard area.



10. Cut out the sheet music and slide it into the folds above the keyboard to keep it standing up.
